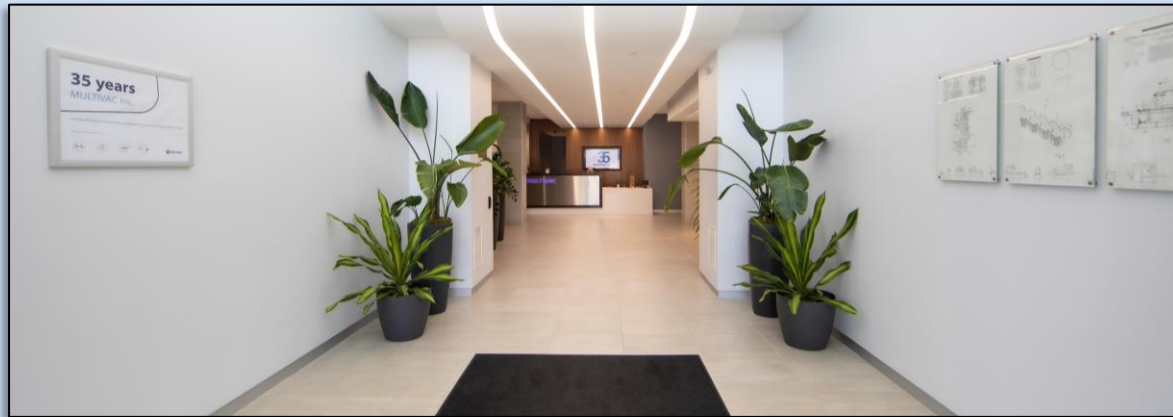

BUILDING

PARKING

At the front entrance near the flag poles, is a section of visitor only parking. When you enter, you'll see the main security desk and lobby directly in front.



SECURITY

SCHEDULES

- Students come from a wide range of employment roles, backgrounds and demographics, cultivating diverse opinions and experiences within our classrooms.



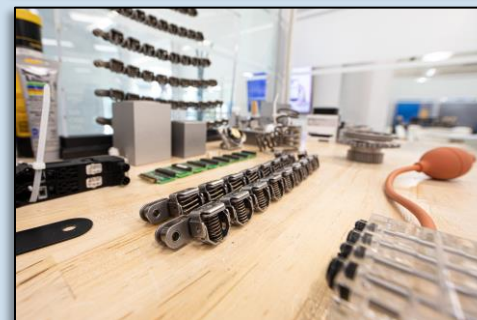
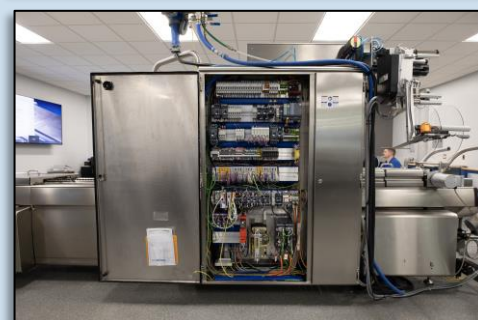
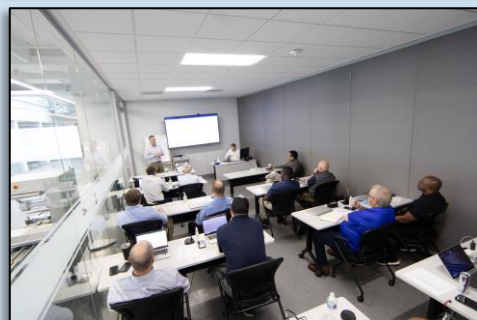


About Our University

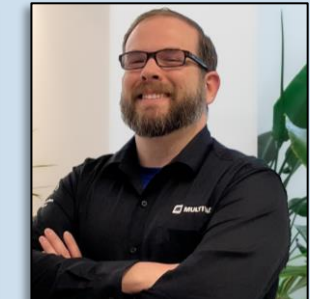

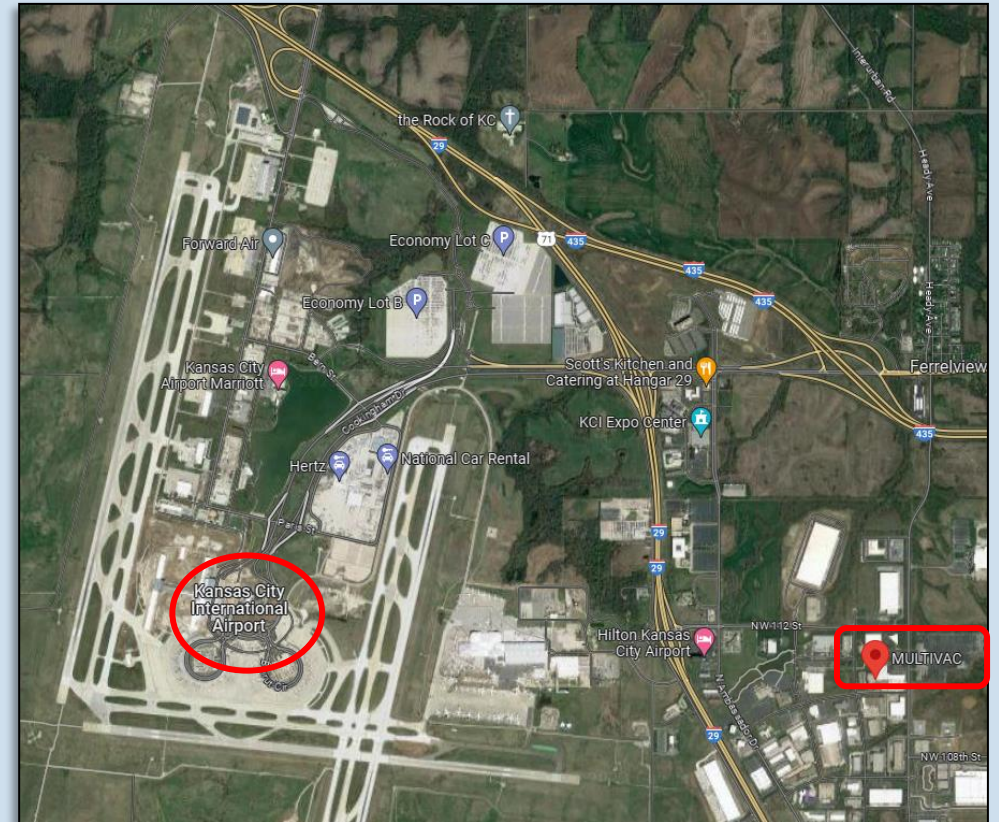

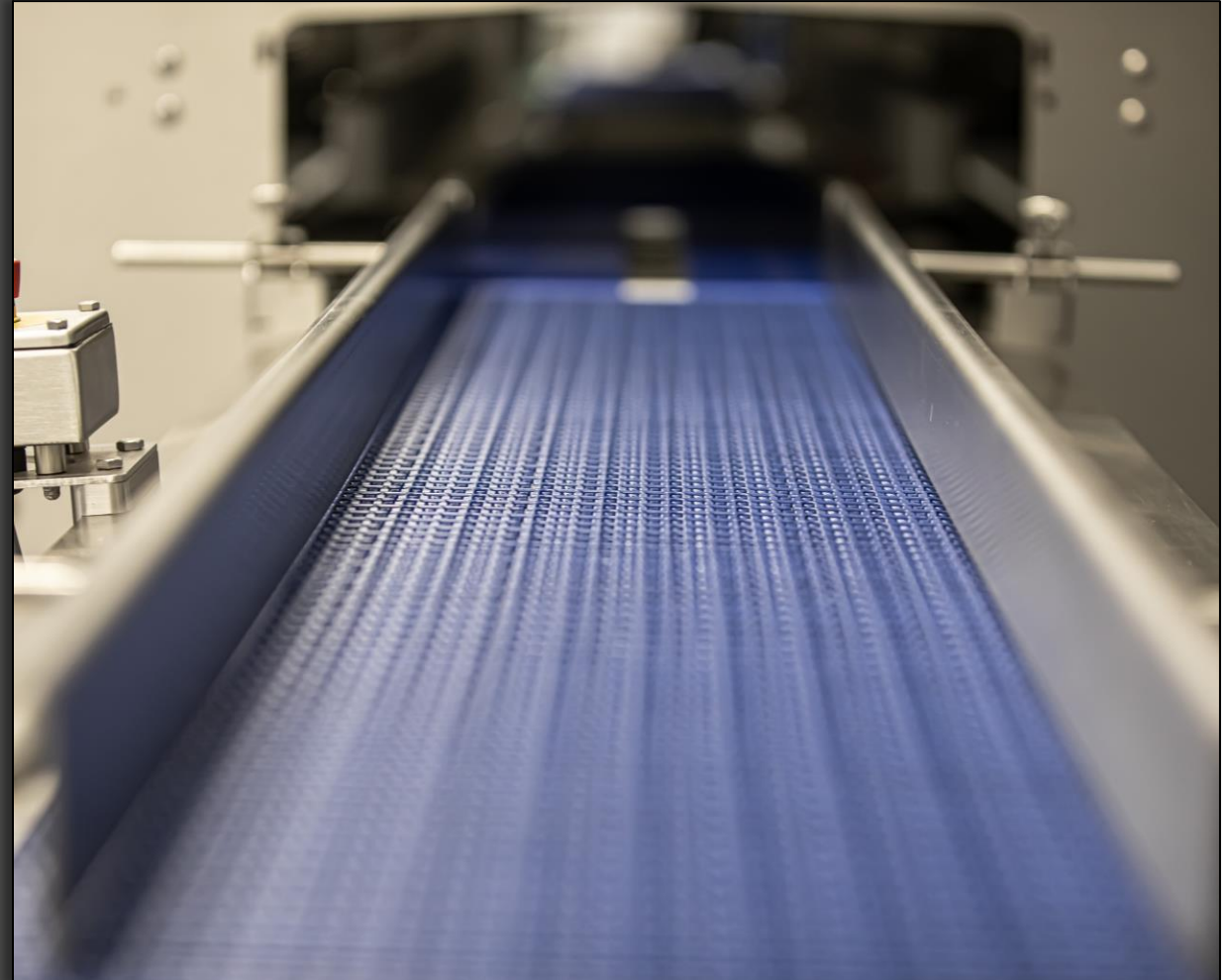

Crossroads: once-vacant warehouses now house carefully curated galleries in the crossroads. 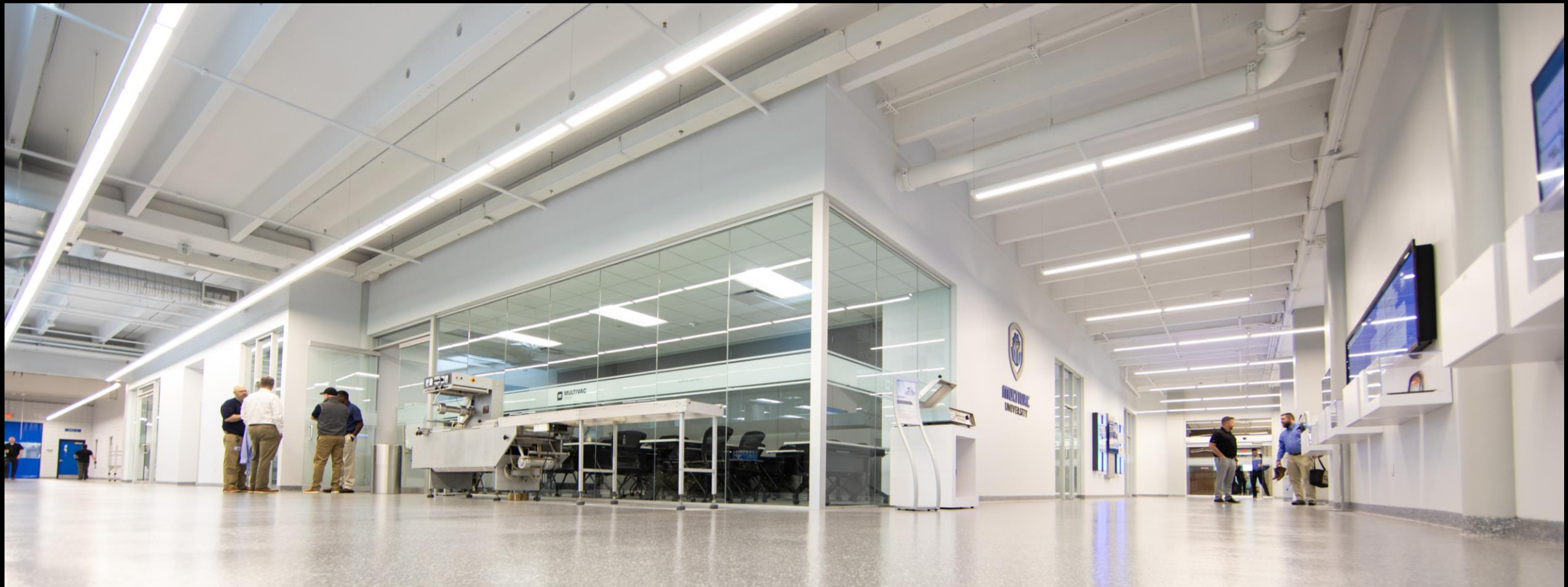
